Worship Leader

Status: Part-time (10 hours per week). This is a new role, and there is potential for this position to grow to half-time.

General Purpose of Position:

First Presbyterian Church of San Mateo is seeking a part-time worship leader (WL) for a contemporary service to be launched in late summer 2017. We are seeking a joyful and humble spirit-led person who is looking to use their God-given vocal and musical talent and experience for Biblically-based worship leadership.

Organizational Relationships:

The WL will work closely with the Pastor and the Director of Youth and Young Adult Ministries.

Supervision and Accountability:

The WL reports directly to the Pastor for spiritual and ministry guidance and is ultimately accountable to the Human Resources Team.

Role and Responsibilities:

- Plan, organize and lead the music and worship components of a weekly Sunday evening service,
- Run weekly rehearsals for a worship band
- Occasionally plan, organize and lead worship for Sunday morning service
- Recruit, train, lead, disciple, equip, and shepherd volunteers
- Stay current with trends in worship music, arts, and technology; learn and introduce new songs

- Committed to being a fully-devoted follower of Jesus
- Talented vocally, with strong musical experience with guitar; other instruments a plus, especially keyboard
- Able to lead worship in a range of styles, from contemplative to more energetic

- Demonstrated love for people, willing to invest time and energy in others
- Able to maintain confidentiality and present oneself professionally at all times
- Good organizational skills with the ability to multi-task, prioritize and be flexible
- Strong verbal and written communication skills

 - Rehearsal for Sunday evening worship
 - Weekly staff meeting
 - Sunday morning worship (and related rehearsals), as occasionally requested
