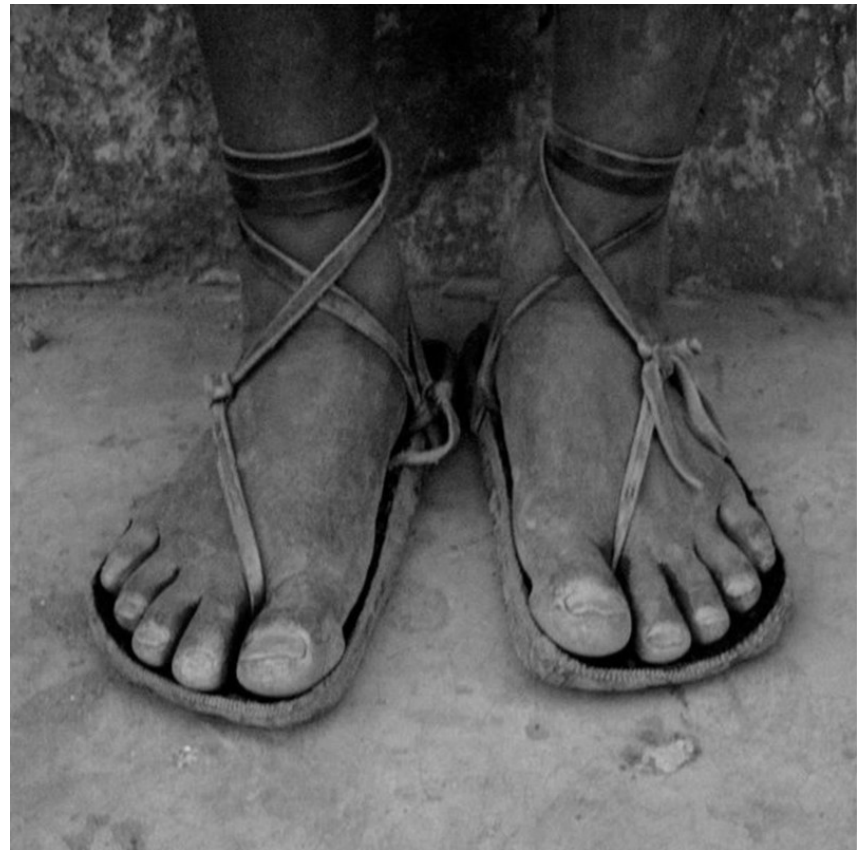

Communion

The bread and juice of the sacrament are served today by a method called intinction. Worshipers are invited to come forward row by row, tear off a portion of bread, and dip it into the cup, thereby receiving the two elements together. If you prefer receiving the sacrament by the traditional method of bread with a small individual cup, proceed past the center stations to the side aisles where you will be served. If you are not able to come forward, let the servers know and they will come to where you are sitting. Gluten-free bread is available at the traditional stations.

Here's what a day in the life of Don McCurry was like on Saturday January 19th "I went with Wes Tucker to Sterling, Colorado and we arrived before the snow. Dr. Van and his wife, Nancy, hosted me while I stayed there. The next day I went to the Berea Sunday School class and had a wonderful time with them. Then I went to take a rest. At 1:45pm, I taught the Perspectives class for two hours at the Baptist Church. It went extremely well. After that, I met for several hours with Dr. Van and several young colleagues in his home until 9pm. Then I went to bed." Unfortunately the next day Don suffered from a mild stroke which has affected his ability to read and speak. He has been showing signs of improvement and hopes he can complete a book he has been writing. He is surrounded by caring family and friends while he undergoes physical therapy.

Prayer Request: Don writes "Pray for us to improve rapidly. I will not be speaking publicly until I get well. Meanwhile I will study the Word of God, pray, sing hymns, and most of all try to write."
