

### Community Outreach Focus: Rebuilding Day

FPCSM will be participating in the Rebuilding Together National Rebuilding Day, joining with other churches and other organizations to improve the homes and lives of low-income homeowners.

Rebuilding Together Peninsula provides renovation and repair services for the Peninsula's most vulnerable homeowners—low-income seniors, veterans, persons with disabilities, and families with children. The day involves critical home repairs, installing disabled access ramps, landscaping, and painting. This is an opportunity for 15-20 volunteers from FPCSM to serve on **Saturday, April 28**. There will also be opportunity to volunteer in the setup and preparation work needed before the Rebuilding Day.
